A **Havan**, also known as **Homa**, is a sacred fire ritual deeply rooted in Vedic traditions. It involves offering materials like ghee, grains, and herbs into a consecrated fire while chanting mantras. The fire is considered a divine medium that carries these offerings to the deities, symbolizing purification and a connection between the human and cosmic realms.

Havans are performed for various purposes, such as seeking blessings, purification, or marking significant life events like weddings or naming ceremonies. The ritual is believed to dispel negative energies and invoke positive vibrations.

Performing a Havan has several spiritual, environmental, and psychological benefits:

Spiritual Growth: It fosters a connection with divine energies, promoting inner peace and spiritual well-being.

Purification: The ritual purifies the environment by releasing medicinal properties from the ingredients used, such as ghee and herbs.

Stress Reduction: Chanting mantras during the Havan has a calming effect on the mind, reducing stress and enhancing mental clarity.

Health Benefits: The smoke from the Havan can eliminate harmful bacteria and purify the air, contributing to better health.
