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A BRIEF NOTE ABOUT THE SCHOOL

The D.A.V Group of Schools, Chennai, is an embodiment of Dayanand Anglo-Vedic movement that began in 1886. It was inspired by Swami Dayanand Saraswathi, the founder of Arya Samaj with the aim of building a knowledge- driven society based on Vedic Principles.

The seeds of the D.A.V Group of Schools were sown in Chennai, in the year 1970, by dedicated visionaries under the auspices of Tamil Nadu Arya Samaj Educational Society (TNAES), with a vision to provide, affordable, value based, quality education. The schools believe in the Vedic Way of Life.

The Tamil Nadu Arya Samaj Educational Society, registered under the Societies Act is managing the D.A.V Group of Schools. The Society runs 5 full-fledged Senior Secondary Schools affiliated to the CBSE, New Delhi and one Higher Secondary School at Gill Nagar, recognized by the Tamil Nadu State Board in Chennai. The Society governs two Government aided schools and one Vocational Training Centre in Chennai. The D.A.V School at Puducherry was started in 2017 and is growing every year. The recent addition to the D.A.V

family is the school at Pallikaranai, with strength of about 2500 in the year of inception (2022). The Society also manages three schools for BHEL, one at Ranipet and two at Tiruchirappalli and three private schools namely D.A.V. Sarada Eashwar Vidyalaya, S.M.Fomra, and The First School.

With 50-years of legacy and experience, the group of schools has continued to burgeon and impart highest levels of moral excellence, which stand as a testimony for the perseverance by teachers and students alike. Upholding the standards set by the past academicians, the institution continues to provide high quality, affordable and value-based education that encourages a sense of team spirit, individual effort and accomplishments.

Keeping in line with the values and compassion of the visionaries who started the school, the Board of Management consistently handholds for various endeavours with other schools, as academic associates. We have 19 Associate Schools with whom we have partnered for the betterment of teaching and learning as a community. To inculcate in children a sense of gratitude, compassion and empathy, the Seva maithri programme was introduced. Students are given an opportunity to interact with children with special needs, residents of homes for senior citizens and serve them with a sense of humility.

They are also helped to visit and take care of animals at Animal Care homes, Goshalas, Farms and also experience the significance of dignity of labour.

The school organizes Career Counselling Programmes for students of classes VIII to XII. Eminent people from relevant industries and distinguished alumni are invited to address the students.

The programme is held online, every first and third Saturday for both D. A.V and non-D.A.V students. Students are encouraged to enroll for the program at no additional cost and benefit from the same. We encourage the parents also to attend the program to help the ward choose a career.

In tune with the present times, to help children, parents and teachers who have a medical need, assistance is provided by experienced medical professionals through project Prashasti, a notable venture of the group.

Professional Counselling is available for students and parents, who wish to avail the same, apart from the regular Counselling services at school. Parents may contact the Headmistress / Principal for any such support.

In continuance of the pursuit of excellence in academics and to provide rootedness in our culture, the group has ventured into publishing textbooks that follow Indic-culture, are affordable, contemporary and value- based with a thought that good teachers make a good society, the Post Graduate Certificate in Education Programme was initiated and continues to serve the cause of Education. Teacher training along with practical exposure is the hall mark of the course.

Classes VIII to XII: Grey full trousers (baggy trousers not allowed) half sleeved grey and white checked shirt with school monogram stitched on the left pocket of the shirt, Black Vegan sports shoes on the days of PET period, Black Shoes (model and brand prescribed by the school), Black socks and school belt.

PET Uniform: School Pant, House T-Shirt and Sports shoes (model and brand prescribed by the school)

GIRLS

Classes LKG & UKG: White checked blouse, grey 'A' line frock, Black ribbon / Black hair band, Black socks, Black shoes (model and brand prescribed by the school). School monogram has to be stitched in the centre of the 'A' line frock.

Classes I to V: Grey pinafore, grey and white checked blouse, Black shoes (model and brand prescribed by the school), Black socks, Black ribbon / hair band. School monogram should be stitched on the left sleeve of the grey blouse.

Classes VI to XII: Grey salwar, grey and white checked kameez, grey waist coat, Black Shoes (model and brand prescribed by the school) Black socks, Black ribbons / hair band. School monogram has to be stitched on the left sleeve of the kameez.

HOUSES

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Attendance on the last working day before a vacation and the reopening day is compulsory. An extended holiday combined with any vacation will not be condoned.
- 2. A pupil may avail of leave only with prior permission, except in unforeseen cases. In case of an emergency, the pupil must ensure that a leave application reaches the office, or the class teacher must be informed on the first day of absence. Students will not be permitted to enter the class without a letter from the parent in this regard. Parents are requested not to apply for leave for their wards in conjunction with declared school holidays or to extend holidays over weekends.

- All leave applications exceeding two days are to be addressed to the Principal by the pupil's parent/guardian. Applications for short durations (two days or less) are to be addressed to the class teacher and also entered and endorsed by the class teacher in the format provided in the calendar.
- 4. Any pupil availing of sick leave shall be required to produce a medical certificate and a prescription signed by a doctor.
- 5. Late coming to school should be strictly avoided. Habitual late coming is punishable, and such students shall not be allowed to attend school.
- 6. In the case of unauthorized absence for 10 days or more, the student's name will be removed from the rolls.
- 7. Pupils requiring leave during any part of the day, regardless of the reason, must obtain the Principal's permission in person, supported by a written request from the parent. Pupils will be permitted to leave only with the parent or guardian.
- 8. Every pupil is required to maintain an attendance of not less than 85% of the working days in a school year. Failure to do so may affect promotion to the next class.
- Absenteeism on days preceding Examinations or Periodic Tests shall be viewed seriously. Parents must explain the reason to the Principal in person.
- Parents must ensure that their wards are present for all examinations.
- Physical Education is compulsory for all pupils up to Class XII.
 Students with less than 80% attendance in PE classes may not be considered for promotion.
- Academic dishonesty (e.g., malpractice in record work, projects, class tests, examinations, etc.) shall warrant severe punishment. In serious cases, at the Principal's discretion, the guilty student may be issued a Transfer Certificate (TC).

- 13. Students shall be assigned seats in the classroom by the class teacher, and they must adhere to the assigned seating.
- 14. Parents are requested to send packed lunch only through their wards. The watchman has been strictly instructed not to collect lunch bags or any other material from anyone, including parents, for security reasons.
- 15. Students are not permitted to carry non-vegetarian food to school.

16. *Dispersal Timings:*

a. LKG: 12:00 noon

b. UKG: 1:45 p.m.

c. Classes I to V: 2:00 p.m.

d. Classes VI to XII: 2:40 p.m.

- 17. Parents must ensure that their wards leave school promptly.
- 18. Parents must ensure that students carry only the textbooks, notebooks, and materials required for that day. Unnecessary items are discouraged.
- 19. Students must adhere to the school norms for proper appearance, including belt, clean shoes and socks, short and clean nails, and trimmed hair for boys. Girls must neatly braid their hair into two plaits tied with black ribbons. Non-compliance will lead to strict disciplinary action.
- 20. Students are expected to keep the school premises clean and tidy. Scribbling on walls, littering, damaging furniture, dirtying floors, or spitting will be viewed very seriously.
- 21. Students shall greet each other and their teachers with a traditional "Namaste" and must show respect and obedience towards elders.
- 22. On a teacher entering the classroom, students shall rise and remain standing until asked to sit. At the end of the class, they

- shall again rise, express gratitude, and resume their seats. All classes begin and end with a brief silent prayer.
- 23. Class leaders, deputy leaders, and all students must cooperate with obedience during classes and at every school function, both within and outside the school premises.
- 24. The School Pupil Leader, Assistant School Pupil Leader, House Captains, Vice-Captains, and other Council Members form the School Prefect Council and will assist school authorities in matters of discipline and administration.
- 25. Students are expected to exhibit exemplary behavior at all times, including during short breaks and the long recess.
- 26. Periodic Progress Reports will be sent to parents/guardians to inform them of the student's regularity, conduct, and academic performance.
- 27. Any student who does not return the signed progress report within two days will not be allowed to attend classes.
- 28. Any student who tampers with the progress report or is guilty of any malpractice will face severe disciplinary action.
- 29. If a parent wishes to communicate regarding the progress report, they must make a separate written communication. Parents are advised not to write remarks in the report card.
- Whenever a call is made to parents regarding the child's conduct or academic progress, they are expected to respond promptly in the child's interest.
- 31. Parents are expected to check their ward's school diary daily and acknowledge any communication by signing in the appropriate space. They are also requested to follow the school's recommendations for the benefit of the child.
- 32. No student is permitted to bring money to school unless accompanied by a written note from the teacher. An acknowledgment must be obtained for the same.

- 33. Students or student organizations/clubs are not permitted to collect any funds in cash or cheque from any source. Parents must warn their children against engaging in collections. Violations will be dealt with strictly.
- 34. Parents are advised not to send their children to coaching centers or private tutors. If help is required, they may approach the Principal to enroll the child in school-conducted special classes.
- 35. School teachers are not permitted to provide private tuition at home, in accordance with school rules.
- Students are not permitted to bring cell phones or electronic gadgets to school, in accordance with Government Orders and school regulations. Violations will attract strict disciplinary action.
- 37. In emergency situations where a mobile phone needs to be sent, a written request from the parent is required. The device must be handed over to the school office or class teacher immediately upon arrival. Failure to follow this procedure will be treated as a violation of school rule
- 38. Random checking of bags shall be conducted on any day that the child is in school or in a school program. The bags can be checked for the following (i) Mobile phones; (ii) Extra books not required by students as per timetable; (iii) Story books other than school library books; (iv) Any other unwanted material etc. In case of finding unwarranted material in the bag, suitable disciplinary action shall be initiated.
- 39. Application for Transfer Certificate, signed by both the parents must be handed over at the office by the parent in person.
- 40. This School diary should be brought to school daily and entries regarding, Daily Work, Communication, Out pass record, and other details should be duly filled in as and when required.
- 41. The presence of parents for the Parents-Teachers Meeting is highly encouraged. Kindly follow the schedule given by the class teacher for the same.

- 42. Parents are requested to contact the Class teacher to get prior appointment to meet the principal.
- 43. Student should take care of the school properties including furniture, T.V. and other equipment. In case of any breakage, the student has to pay the fine.
- 44. We would like to inform the parents that the school will feature our students photos in the school website to showcase their participation in various school activities or sports events.
