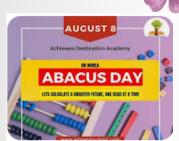






#### WORLD ABACUSDAY

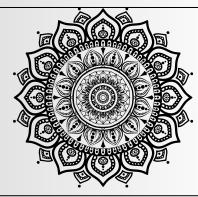
The rhythmic and collective chanting created an atmosphere filled with positive vibrations and spiritual energy, leaving everyone with a sense of peace and devotion.

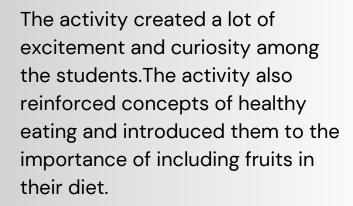






Magic box and Pulao day The Magic Box Activity with real fruits was conducted for our young learners to provide a fun and interactive way of exploring the world of fruits through their senses.

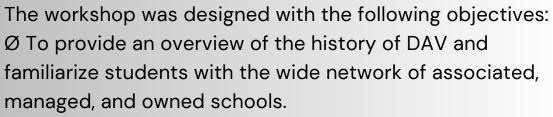

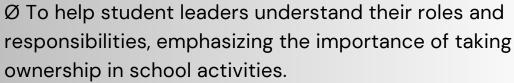

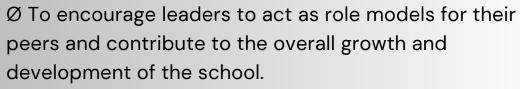
