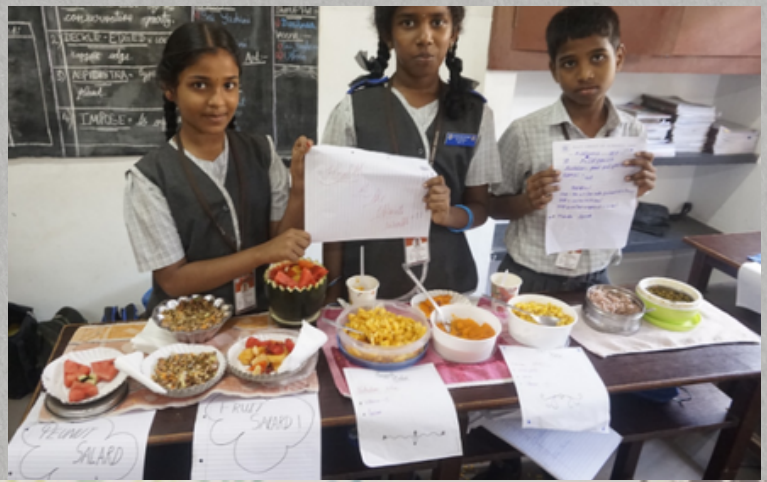


World Food Day–Report

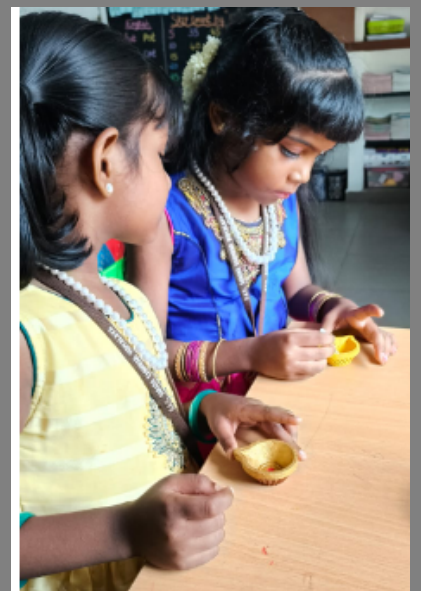
Diwali Celebration Report

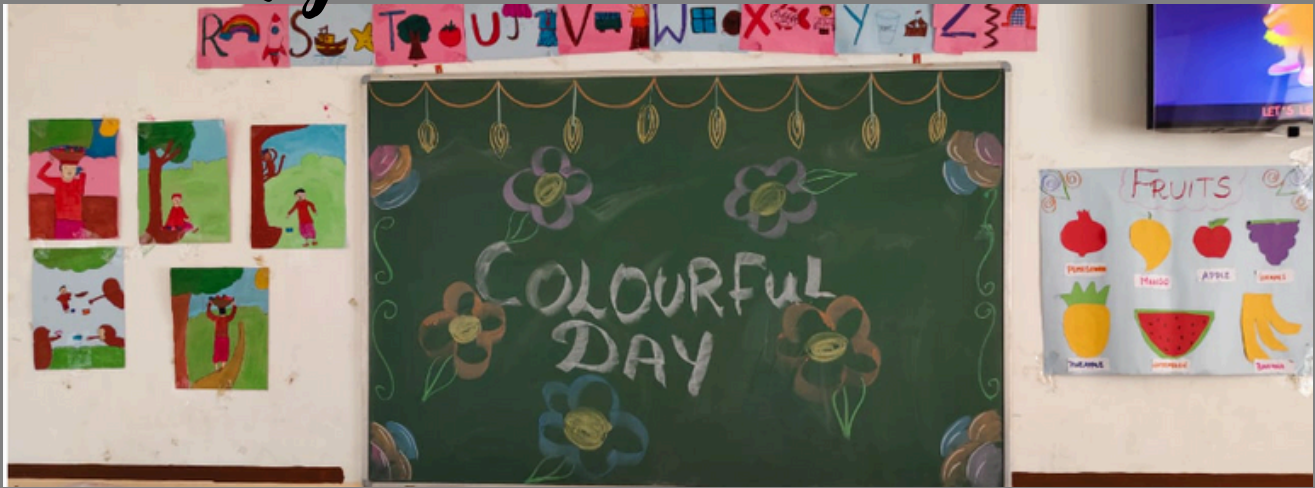

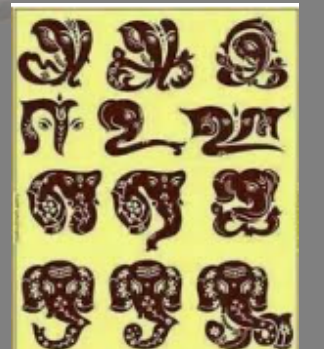
FIELD TRIP TO DAKSHIN CHITRA

Classroom Cleanliness

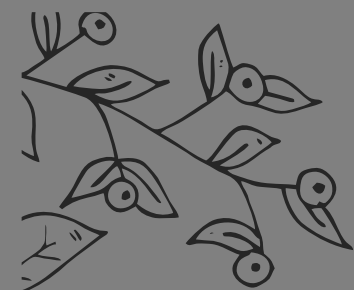
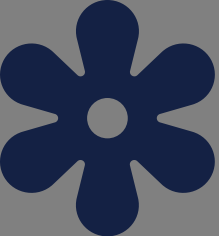
