KG Book Review Meeting




15 th November 2025



Activities like these nurture creativity, build confidence, and strengthen foundational learning skills. Overall, it was a delightful learning experience filled with smiles and curiosity.










Gross Motor Skills Activity




Number Train Activity






KG GalleryNational Education Day Activity








SHADOW MATCHING











