India – A River That Named a Nation

Where the Name Came From

- The name India comes from the Indus River
- Ancient Persians called the river “Hindu”
- The Greeks changed it to “Indos”
- Over time, it became India

- People living in India never originally called their land “India”
 - Ancient names included: Bharat, Hindustan

The country has multiple official names, but “India” became global due to foreign travelers and colonizers.



Japan – “The Land of the Rising Sun”

What Japan Calls Itself

- Japanese people call their country Nihon or Nippon
- Meaning: “Origin of the Sun”

How the World Got “Japan”

- Chinese pronunciation sounded like “Cipan”
- Marco Polo heard it as “Jipangu”
- Europeans later simplified it to Japan

Japan is called the “Land of the Rising Sun” because it lies east of China, where the sun appears to rise.


Australia's name existed before anyone from Europe actually saw it.





All the participants were awarded medals as a token of appreciation for their spirited performance and enthusiastic participation.






INTER-DAV VOLLEY BALL TOURNAMENT

UNNATHI- STUDY CAMP


- A Study Camp for the students of Classes X and XII was successfully conducted at DAV Pallikaranai Campus from 25th to 30th December.






CLASSROOM ACTIVITY
