"ISRO: EXPLORING SPACE, EMPOWERING INDIA"

The **Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO)** is India's national space agency, responsible for space research, satellite launches, and interplanetary missions. It has achieved remarkable milestones in space exploration, communication, and earth observation.

■ Major ISRO missions

1975 – Aryabhata

India's first satellite for scientific experiments in space.



1980 – Rohini satellite series

Earth observation satellites to test India's launch capabilities.



1983 – Insat-1a

India's first communication and meteorology satellite.



1988 – IRS-1a

First earth observation satellite for mapping and resource monitoring.

1992 – INSAT-2a

Advanced communication satellite improving telecommunication and broadcasting.



2008 – Chandrayaan-1

India's first lunar mission; discovered water molecules on the moon.

2013 – Mangalyaan (Mars Orbiter Mission)

India became the first Asian country to reach Mars orbit on its first attempt.

2019 – Chandrayaan-2

Lunar mission with orbiter, lander (Vikram), and rover (Pragyan) for moon exploration.

2023 – Aditya-L1 (upcoming)

India's first solar mission to study the sun's outer layers.




Upcoming – Gaganyaan & Chandrayaan-3

The final day of the fest highlighted both sports and cultural talents of our students.


The Girls' Throwball team emerged as Winners, demonstrating excellent coordination and skill. The girls also participated confidently in Kho Kho events.

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



As part of the Kaushal Kendram programme, an activity session was conducted on 23/01/2026 for Grade VII and VIII students in the Library.


The session was led by Sister Malarvizhi on the topic "How to Measure Blood Pressure (BP)".

In the month of January 2026, the Chennai Book Fair was held at the YMCA Grounds, drawing book lovers from all walks of life.



KG PONGAL CELEBRATION REPORT











Overall, the activities helped build readiness for letter writing and boosted students' confidence. Continuous practice will further enhance their writing skills and pencil control.
